

Angelos S. Daniilidis is Professor in Obstetrics and Gynecology at the Medical School of Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. He is currently working to the 1st University Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Papageorgiou General Hospital of Thessaloniki in Greece. His clinical and academic interest is focused on general obstetrics and gynecology, with particular emphasis on endoscopic surgery, reproductive medicine as well as quality improvement in clinical and educational practice.

He graduated from the Medical School of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki in 1996 and specialized in Obstetrics - Gynecology in Great Britain (Edinburgh and Glasgow) and in Greece at the Hippocratic Hospital of Thessaloniki. He received his PhD from the Medical School of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki in 2007. He subspecialized in gynecological endoscopy for 24 months at Leuven University Clinic in Belgium, at Clermond Ferrand in France and Cagliari , Pisa in Italy in 2006, 2012, 2017 and 2025 respectively. He is also subspecialized in reproductive medicine for three years at Papagerogiou Reproductive Medicine Unit in Greece. He holds a Master's Degree in Medical Research Methodology from Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (2017) and a Master's Degree in Public administration of Health Services from University of Pafos Cyprus. He also holds a diploma in endoscopic surgery from the European Society of Endoscopy (MIGS-Minimally Invasive Gynecological Surgery-ESGE), certified robotic surgeon by SERGS and colposcopy diploma (BSCCP) as well as family planning (DFFP) of the British College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists. Finally, he is a certified instructor of Advanced Life Support in Obstetrics (ALSO), colposcopy by (RCOG) and instructor in gynecological endoscopy (ESGE and ISGE). He is also certified in obstetrics ultrasound by the Fetal Medicine Foundation.

From 2016-2020 he was elected member of the European Gynecological Endoscopy Society (ESGE) advisory board. He is deputy secretary for the ESG (European Society of Gynaecology). He is current member of the SIG (special interest group) in endometriosis of ESGE. He is coordinator elect of the SIG in reproductive surgery of ESHRE (European Society of Human reproduction). He is coordinator of the SIG in endometriosis for ISGE (International Society of Gynecological Endoscopy). He is a current member of the board of the Greek Society of Gynecological Endoscopy. He is vice president of the Society in Obstetrics and Gynaecology of Thessaloniki. Since 2021 he is director of the Master of Science (MSC) in: <Surgical applications of endoscopic surgery in gynecology> under the auspices of Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. He has organized more than 20 international and local scientific courses. He has

been invited as a speaker in more than 200 international and Greek congresses and courses. He has been member of the editorial board of Gynecological Surgery (Associate Editor), Hippokratia (Section Editor), Minerva, invited co-editor in Current women's Health, and has been active reviewer in journals as EJOGRB, Journal of Obstetrics and Gynecology, Human Reproduction etc. He has published more than 180 papers in PubMed, Scopus in international and Greek journals accompanied by more than 3000 citations and more than 200 impact factor, as well more than 20 chapters in Greek and International scientific books. Finally, he is the main author of 3 scientific books of obstetrics and gynecology in Greek language.

His native language is Greek and he is fluent in English (Proficiency of Cambridge), Italian (C2, Celi 5 Superiore) and French (B2 Institute Francais).
